Our Local Plan includes key planning policy documents – the Core Strategy and the Places and Policies Local Plan – that explain our vision for Shepway and how we plan to deliver that vision. Local Plan documents are developed or reviewed at different times and may have several stages of development. At each stage of a document’s development we publish the latest version and ask local people, groups and organisations their views.

Core Strategy 2013

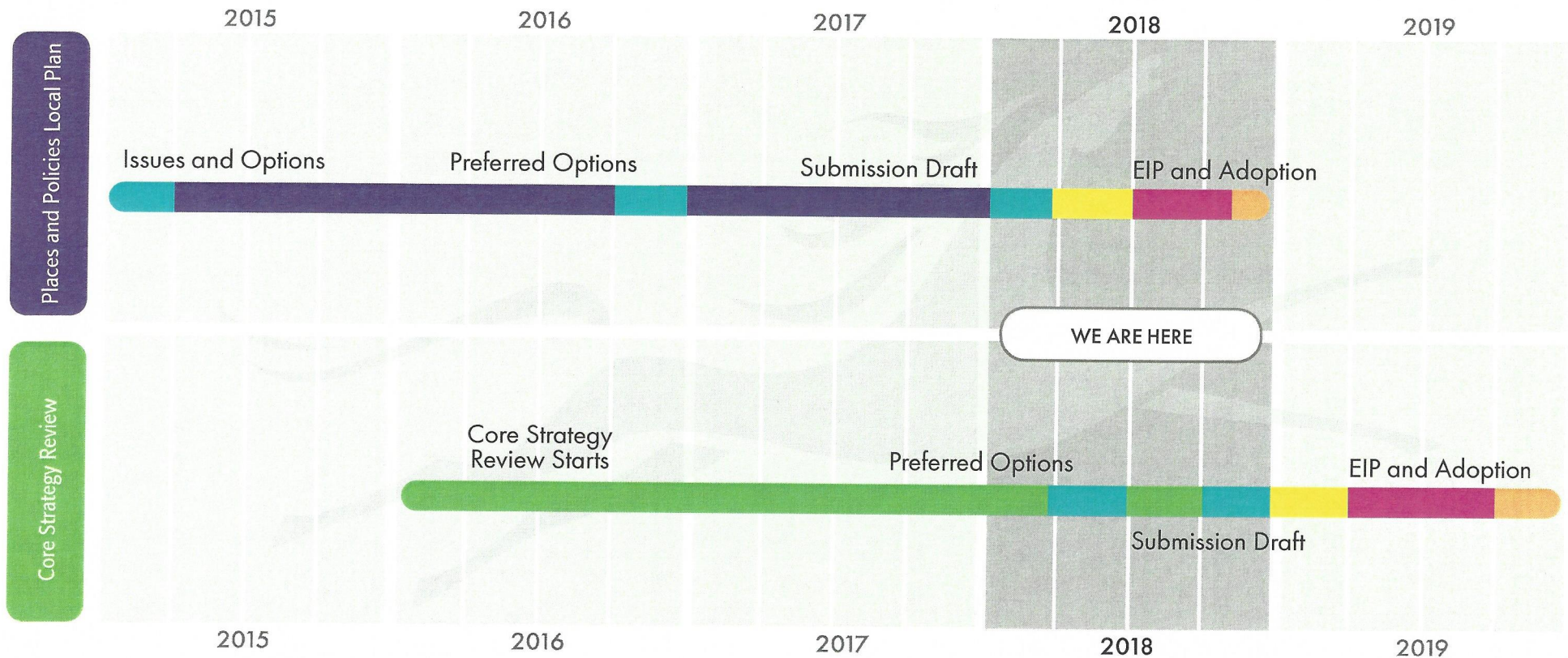
The Core Strategy is the main planning policy document for the district. It looks at the district’s current and future populations, and how we can meet their needs for housing, employment, education, society and transport up to 2031.

Places and Policies Local Plan

The Places and Policies Local Plan identifies specific development sites for 1,600 of the new homes and work spaces we need, as identified in the Core Strategy 2013, and how we want them built.

Core Strategy Review

We are currently reviewing the Core Strategy to make sure it continues to meet local needs beyond 2031 – taking into account changes in population projections, National Planning Guidance and our own Corporate Plan.
